Established in 1924, the Toronto Ski Club is among Collingwoods oldest Ski Clubs. Today, the TSC's private Clubhouse proudly sits at the base of Blue Mountain and boasts fabulous views of the Niagara Escarpment. While the TSC is a private Club, we love opening our doors to guests for events from May 1st through to October 31st each year. Our spectacular Clubhouse lends to a warm & welcoming atmosphere allowing your guests to feel comfortable and at ease, while enjoying total privacy and scenic views. Ceremonies at the TSC are generally enjoyed indoors; the large windows throughout the Club provide beautiful natural light. Our expansive patio is perfect for pre and post ceremony cocktails and receptions. Enjoy the sunshine, spectacular mountainous views, and the starry sky at night.



WHY BOOK TSC?

Because our food and beverage team operates seasonally, we are unique in that while we offer our venue as a rental, we do not provide food and beverage for off-season events. This sets us apart from other venues in the area, in that it allows our couples the felxibility to choose their own vendors, and most importantly, host your own bar! This can result in substantial financial savings, as well as allow you the freedom to choose your own spirits.

Conveniently located at the base of Blue Mountain, we are a short walk or drive to Blue Mountain Village, where there is an abundance of accommoadtion, as well as restaurants, nightlife and activities for your guests to enjoy!

Have a lot of guests driving? The TSC has a copious amount of complimentary guest parking.

CLUBHOUSE RENTAL \$4000 (+HST)

Our Clubhouse comfortably accommoadtes 100-240 people for a dinner service and up to 400 people for a cocktail reception, making it the perfect venue for an informal gathering, or a formal fine-dining event.

Rental includes:

- 3 days access to the Clubhouse: 9am-5pm Friday, 12pm-2am Saturday, 10am-4pm Sunday
 - Private patio area backing onto Blue Mountain
 - Built in dance floor
 - Raised area to highlight the head table or ceremony
- Single consultation meeting (there is an additional \$200 charge for extra meetings outside of the original consultation)



Outside Vendors: Bar Service and catering

- A caterer and any other 3rd party hired has to show certificates of insurance, showing both the individual renting the facility and the Toronto Ski Club named as insured.
- All bartenders and servers must provide a copy of their smart serve certificate.
- Liquor service is available between the hours of 12pm and 1am.
- A **Special Occasion Permit** must be provided by the individual renting the venue and it must be prominently displayed at all times during the event.
- A shuttle service must be provided for guests in attendance.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES AND FEES

*Socan & ReSound Fees - Socan is a fee paid to the society of composers, authors and music publishers of Canada for your right to use music, which is copyrighted; this will be applied to your invoice. Socan rates are based on the number of attendees. ReSound is a fee payable to the use of recorded music during events. Rates are based on numbers and whether dancing will be taking place.

*If you require additional meetings outside the consultation meeting there is an additional charge of \$200 per meeting.



DAMAGES, LIABILITIES & SECURITY

The Toronto Ski Club shall not assume responsibility for, damage to, or loss of property or personal effects of any kind left at the Club prior to, during or following your function.Please make necessary arrangements to have items removed at the end of your event. Also, the Club does not accept responsibility for any damages to or loss of vehicles located in the parking lot or about the Toronto Ski Club.

A damage fee will be charged if any special cleaning or repair to the venue is required. Please note: under no circumstances is confetti permitted. A \$200 charge will be applied if confetti, or any facsimile, is used in any fashion. All decorations must conform to municipal codes and fire ordinance rules. The Club does not permit affixing of anything to walls, floors or ceiling by use of nails, staples, tapes or any other substance, unless pre-approved in writing by management during the planning of your event.

Individuals renting the venue have to obtain a **Special Occasion/Event Policy** through their personal insurance and show Toronto Ski Club as additionally insured for 5 million of Liability. The **Special Occasion Permit** is needed to be purchased through the LCBO to get the event policy.

The caterer and any other 3rd party hired has to show certificates of insurance, showing both the individual renting the facility and the Toronto Ski Club named as insured.



SMOKING POLICY & DECOR

The Toronto Ski Club is a non-smoking facility without exception. The includes the deck and patio.

Decor must be approved by the management of the Toronto Ski Club in accordance of the municipal bylaws and codes. No open flame candles are permitted.

DEPOSITS

We encourage you to reserve and book your date as soon as possible. Dates will not be held or reserved until the contract is signed and a deposit has been made.

To confirm and secure your date, an initial deposit will be required. We accept cheques, credit cards and cash as acceptable methods of payment.

Deposit #1 - a non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 is required to secure the date of your event.

Deposit #2 - Fourteen days prior to the event date the balance of your venue cost is due, using your final numbers.

Damage Deposit - A damage/cleanng deposit of \$2,000 is required, payable fourteen days prior to the event date. The full deposit will only be refunded after an inspection of the building by TSC staff, ensuring the building is damage free and clean.

The individual renting the venue assumes all responsibility for damages to property rented to the client that may be caused by guests or invitees.
